About Netherlands

- The name Netherlands literally meaning "Lower Countries" came about due to its low land and flat geography with only about 50% of its land exceeding one meter above the sea level.
- Most of the areas are below sea level and are man-made.
- Since the late 16th century, large areas (polders) have been reclaimed from the sea and lakes amounting to nearly 17% of the country's current land mass.
- The Netherlands covers around 41,000 square kilometers and has a population of about 16 million.
- Country with one of the highest English-speaking population in Europe (above 90%).



About Netherlands

- With a rich cultural heritage the country has been home to many of history's most famous names in the areas of Art, Literature, Philosophy and Science. It also has a long history of international trade having forged links with countries around the world, bringing together knowledge, skills, business and ideas.
- The Netherlands consists of twelve provinces of which two of the provinces North Netherlands and South Netherlands are the most densely populated and encompass the popular cities of Amsterdam, Rotterdam and The Hague.

Why Study in Netherlands?

- **Quality Education**- Educational opportunities of the highest standards and a multicultural population.
- **Post study work visa**- 1 year (for all bachelor's and Master's program)
- **Courses taught in English**- The Universities of Netherlands charge comparatively low tuition fees from international students and offer Master's programs exclusively taught in English.
- **Part time Jobs**- Students can work up to 16 hours/week. Typical part time earning are €10 to €15 per hour.
- **Employment**- Netherlands is counted amongst one of the most industrialized countries in the world. Post study work Visa of 1 year is offered to the students to take up a job and gain international exposure after completion of their studies.

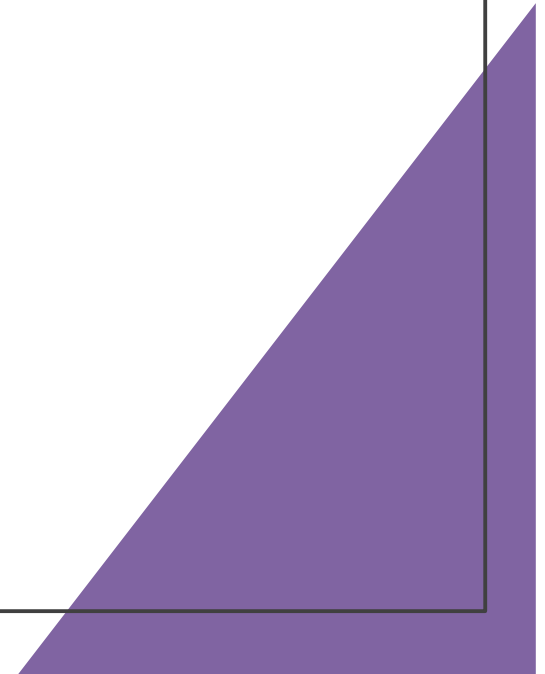

Entry Requirements

Direct Entry to Bachelor's or Master's:

Academic percentage–

- ✓ 60-65% and above in previous education. (High ranked Universities may need 70% and above)
- ✓ Mathematics can be a requirement for applying to a Bachelor's program in some universities
- ✓ GMAT is required for an MBA in high ranked universities.

IELTS-

- ✓ Masters: 6.5 with no band less than 6.0
 - ✓ Bachelors: 6.5 with no band less than 6.0

Visa Process

- Nationals of countries outside the EU who wish to come to the Netherlands for a stay of more than three months need an authorization for temporary stay (MVV).
- The University will process the visa application (MVV) by applying for the same in the Netherlands on behalf of the students.
- Visa shall be received in around 4-8 weeks. Student needs to go for Biometrics at the local Embassy/Consulate.
- On arriving in the Netherlands, the University will apply for a residence permit on behalf of the student.
- The Fees for Visa and residence permit application is usually included in the University Tuition fees package which is approx. **€ 243**



Documents Required for Visa

- **LEGALISED ACADEMIC DOCUMENTS ARE REQUIRED FOR VISA.**
- **Documents must be translated if not in ENGLISH**
- You meet the general [requirements that apply to everyone](#).
- You have proof of registration or temporary proof of registration as a student at a university or institute of higher professional education (in Dutch: hoger beroepsonderwijs or HBO).
- Your study program is accredited: this means that it has been recognized by Accreditation Organization of the Netherlands and Flanders or [NVAO](#) (in the Netherlands) or the European Quality Assurance Register for Higher Education or [EQAR](#) (Europe).
- Your educational institution is a [recognised sponsor with the IND](#).
- You will enroll on a full-time study program.
- You meet the [income requirements](#).





Documents Required for Visa

- **FINANCIALS**

One year living expense must be shown – EUR 15,000 + Balance tuition fees.

Acceptable means:

Sponsorship – Immediate family members

Education Loan

Savings Account

Fixed Deposits

SOME UNIVERITIES MAY REQUIRE A BLOCKED ACCOUNT

The funds must be 3 months old. Income source will be required.

- Every year you make enough progress in your studies. This means that you obtain at least 50% of the credits for each study year. Your educational institution assesses your progress and lets you know if you have obtained enough credits. What if you do not make enough study progress and your educational institution does not think there is a good reason for this? Then your educational institution will register you at the IND. If you want to know more about study progress monitoring, please contact your educational institution.

Questions*

Ques: What will be the budget for a student going to study a Masters in Netherlands?

Ans: Euro 20,000 to 25,000 approx.

Ques: Do Institutions accept a 3 years Bachelor's or 15 years of education for a Master's?

Ans : Yes, it is accepted.

Ques: Can a student apply without an IELTS score and a final year/12th marksheet for a conditional offer letter?

Ans: No conditional admission is not possible.

Ques: What is the turnaround time for Offer letters from Institutions?

Ans : The turnaround time is around 3 to 6 weeks.

Ques: Are backlogs accepted by Dutch universities?

Ans: No

Ques: A student completed his Bachelor's degree in 2010 and is working since then. He has a total work experience of 9 years. Can the student apply for a Masters' course?

Ans: Yes

Ques: Can IELTS be waived off in Netherlands?

Ans: No, IELTS is a mandatory requirement.

Ques : If a student has already completed a Master's and would like to pursue a second Master's program in Netherlands, is it possible?

Ans : Yes, a student can apply for a second Master's in Netherlands.

Ques: How much funds does the student need to show at the time of filing visa ? Which funds are acceptable for filing visa ?

Ans: Total tuition fees + living expenses (Euro 15,000 for a year)

Savings Account, Fixed Deposits and Education Loan.
